Dear Secretary Burwell,

We are writing to request that you make necessary changes to the Federal healthcare exchange website to ensure individuals maintain their access to insurance coverage and can easily learn about quality, affordable coverage. There is an important role for the state health officials, agents and brokers, and individuals assisting in the marketplace enrollments to help guide consumers through this important but complicated process. Unfortunately, several flaws continue on the healthcare.gov website and the call center prevents our fully utilizing certified assisters.

- First, we are writing to request that your Department create a dedicated customer service hotline for certified agents and brokers, navigators, marketplace assistors and state health officials to ensure that problems with enrollment are addressed quickly and effectively.
- Second, we request improvements to the healthcare.gov search feature for individuals searching
 for agent and broker contact information within the list of local in-person assistance so that
 constituents can more easily find these resources.
- Third, we believe that amendments need to be made to marketplace coverage application and transaction records to track and record the identifying numbers for all navigator and non-navigator assisters, call-center support personnel and certified agents who assist an enrollee. This will provide better consumer protection, inspire greater cooperation purposes among the various types of individuals providing consumers with application and coverage assistance, and ensure that all who assist an individual are compensated for their work.

The changes outlined above would better employ the expertise of insurance agents and brokers, state health officials and other individuals assisting in the marketplace enrollments to ease the process for our constituents. Implementing these improvements before the next open enrollment could greatly improve the experience of individuals attempting to sign up for healthcare. Thank you for your attention to these issues. We look forward to continuing to work with you on these and other matters.
