- Standard Plans do not follow the typical Highmark plan design structure of identical PCP and Specialist Copays and \$0 Tier 1 Rx
- "Standard" will be included in the plan name

New Plan Designs

Gold 1700 HSA QHDHP On-Exchange

- Now offering our Gold QHDHP on-exchange in 2023
- Lower-cost than our existing Gold \$0 deductible plans
- Eligible to be paired with contributions to a Health Savings Account (HSA)
- This plan is designed for consumers looking for a lower-cost Gold option and/or a richer QHDHP (vs. Bronze 6900)
- "As a reminder, HSA contributions reduce a consumer's taxable income, which could help with consumers around the 400% FPL cutoff for premium tax credits

ILLUSTRATIVE rates for Together Blue Gold plans; individual member

- With the introduction of the American Rescue Plan, the average subsidized member is expected to pay ~\$100-150 more per month
- We expect most members will still see value in Gold plans, as they were our most popular plans in 2020, 2021 and 2022
- Our two "flagship" Gold plans Gold 0 and Premier Gold 0 will be unchanged and keep their \$0 deductible and predictable copay structure
 - The Premier Gold 0 has the \$1,000 lower OOPM and \$75
 Tier 3 Rx copay
 - Premier Gold 0 members will also enjoy our <u>lowest</u> copays and have access to our "Premier" bonus benefits which include: TruHearing, Papa, and a \$25/quarter OTC allowance
- The Standard Gold plan in WV and DE will be lower cost than "non-standard" Gold plans (1700 HSA, 0, Premier 0)

"Premier" Benefits

For members who enroll in our "Premier" plans, they will enjoy some of our richest benefits, but also gain access to unique bonus benefits which include: TruHearing, Papa, and a \$25/quarter OTC allowance

 - Items include: Allergy, cold, and flu medications, first aid supplies, vitamins, dental products
- Allowances are pooled for family coverage (i.e., family of 4 has \$100/quarter to spend)

For the price-sensitive consumers, or those that feel Gold plans no longer fit into their budget if ARPA subsidies expire, we will offer 2 bronze options that support different consumer types

Bronze 3800 – for the consumer most interested in medical benefits

- a. Copays before deductible on all office visits, as well as labs and x-rays
- b. Low deductible for a Bronze plan

Bronze 6900 HSA – for the consumer most interested in pharmacy benefits (or HSA)

- **NEW for 2023:** HDHP drug list, which covers select prescriptions to manage chronic conditions at \$0 before deductible (i.e., free) will be noted in the plan name as "Custom Drug Benefit"
 - Includes popular Rx: 20 of the 25 most filled scripts are on list, as well as 9 of the 10 most filled Tier 3 drugs
 - **Examples:** Lipitor, Metformin, Albuterol, Jardiance, Trulicity, Entresto (full list of prescriptions will be available online)
 - Considered a QHDHP (noted in plan name as "HSA") to allow for taxdeductible contributions to an HSA

Both Bronze plans should be similarly priced after subsidy

2023 Adult Dental and Vision benefits

Regardless of the medical plan you choose, the Adult Dental and Vision benefits are always the same

Adult Dental

- \$50 individual deductible / \$1,250 annual maximum per person (Note: Does not accumulate)
- to medical deductible or MOOP)
- 100% coverage on cleanings (2 free annually), x-rays, sealants
- 80% coverage on minor restorative services (e.g., fillings, repairs of existing crowns)
- 50% coverage on major restorative services (e.g., root canals, new crowns)
- No waiting period longer than 6 months, most benefits have no waiting period
